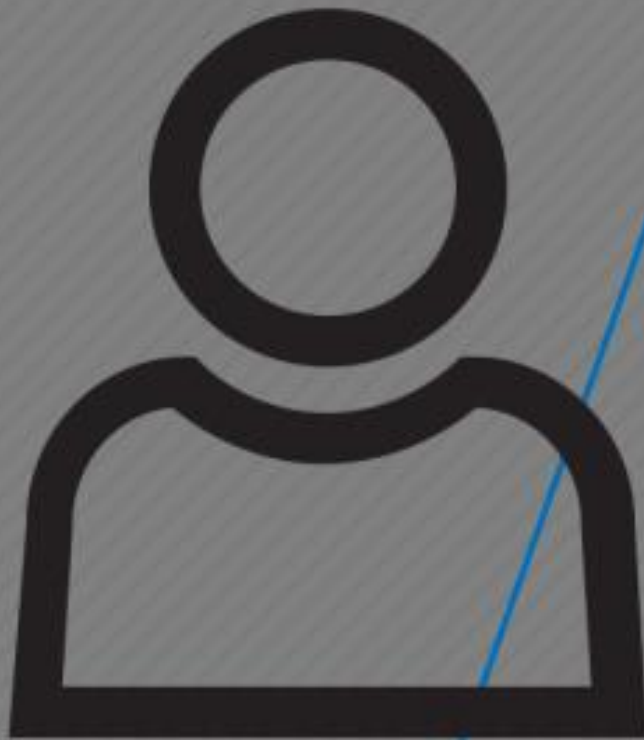

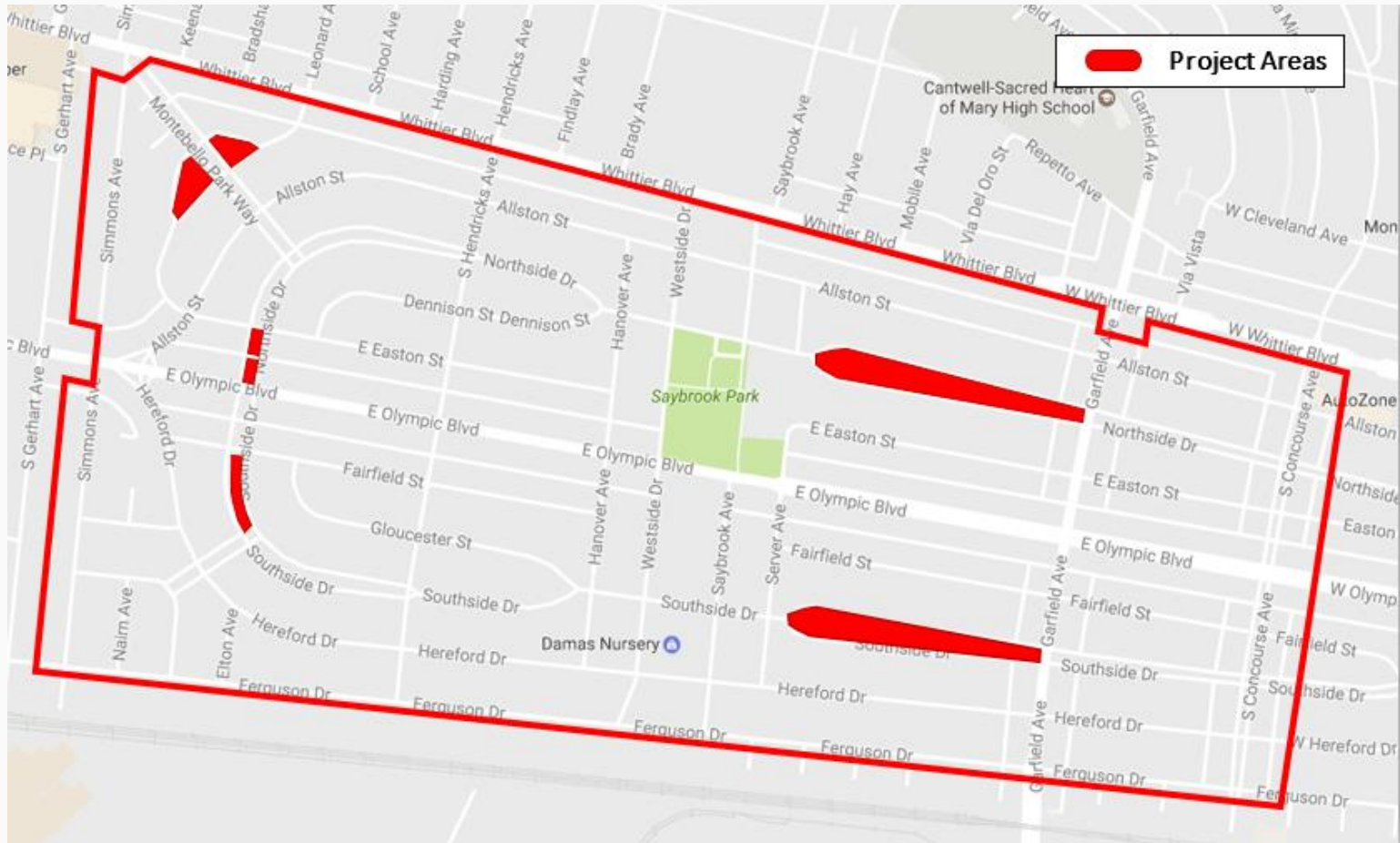

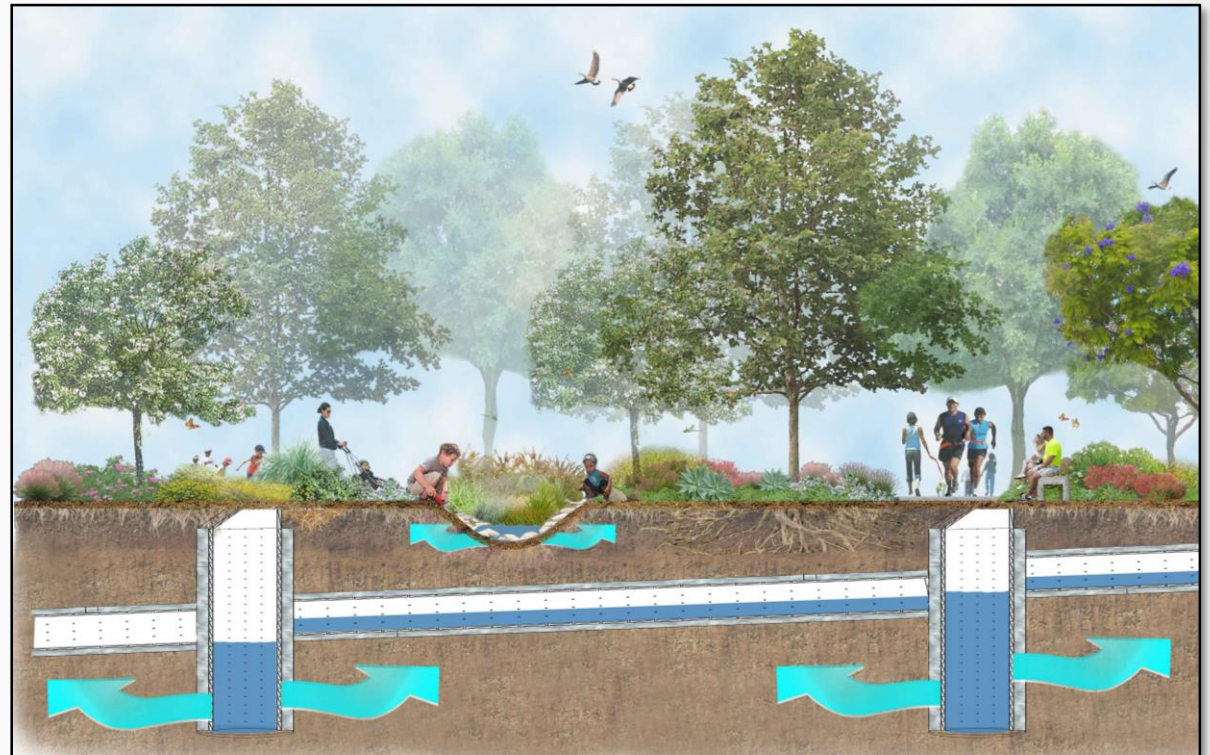

East LA Sustainable Median Stormwater Capture Project

- Project will divert urban and stormwater runoff into drywells within existing roadway medians
- Above-ground improvements
 - Drought tolerant landscaping
 - Picnic Tables/Benches
 - Walking Paths
 - Exercise Equipment
 - Educational Signage



East LA Sustainable Median Stormwater Capture Project

Budget

- Total Estimated Project Cost: \$36M
- Project Partners:
 - Los Angeles County
 - Los Angeles County Flood Control District
 - Monterey Park
 - Montebello
- Other Funding Sources: \$4.5M
 - Prop 1 Stormwater - \$2M
 - CA Urban Greening Grant - \$2.5M

Schedule

- Begin Construction – July 2020
- Complete Construction – Fall 2021

Construction Impacts

- Closure of medians
- Traffic Control

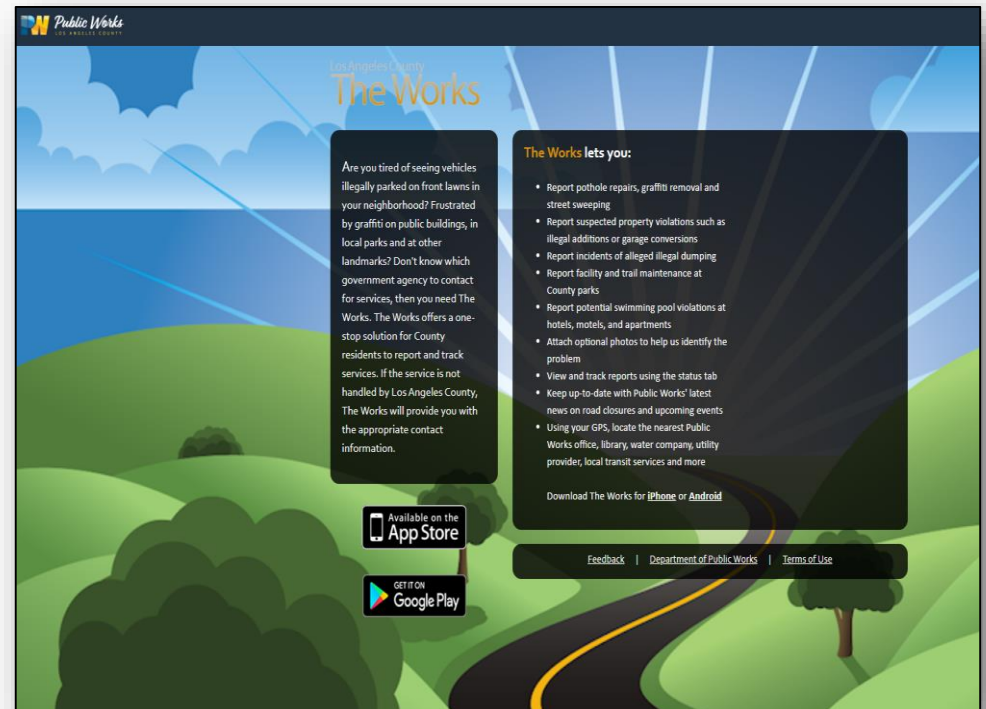
