LA PRIMARIA ELEMENTARY SCHOOL STUDENTS CELEBRATE SAN GABRIEL RIVER EARTH DAY

City Of El Monte – Second and third-grade students from La Primaria Elementary School will join County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works, County and City Officials and local community groups to plant trees and California native flowers in honor of Earth Day.

"In addition to beautifying their neighborhood with native trees and plants, La Primaria students will learn that a few simple behaviors can have a tremendous impact on our environment. Using a reusable bag instead of single-use plastic bags, and putting trash in its proper place are earth-friendly practices that have long-term benefits for local waterways and our communities," said Supervisor Gloria Molina.
