POPULAR HOLLYWOOD BOWL SHUTTLE PROGRAM RENEWED

The County of Los Angeles Board of Supervisors has renewed the Hollywood Bowl Park-and-Ride and Shuttle program for the 2006 Summer season, announced Supervisor Gloria Molina. The program allows patrons to park at various County park-and-ride lots, free of charge, and then take a low-cost express bus from outlying areas or a shuttle from the nearby lots to the Bowl's cultural events. Free parking is not provided at Hollywood & Highland parking lot.

Launched 32 years ago, the shuttle service is designed to help reduce traffic on streets and freeways and give all residents convenient access to the Bowl's Summer Season performance.

Riders are charged \$2.50 each way from remote lots and \$3.00 round trip from nearby parking lots. Patrons with pre-purchased ride tickets for the remote lots get preferential boarding. Last year, about 23 percent of the people attending Bowl programs used the park-and-ride and shuttle services.

Each park-and-ride and shuttle lot will be protected by a uniformed Los Angeles Philharmonic Association guard. In addition to fares, the program is funded in part by the Metropolitan Transportation Authority, and in part by Proposition A funds administered by the County Department of Public Works.
