## **POMONA COMMUTERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF NEWLY RENOVATED RIDESHARE PARKING LOT**

**Pomona, CA** - County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works announces the completion of the newly renovated Fairplex Park and Ride Lot located at 1810 Gillette Road in Pomona.

The revamped lot now features resurfaced and restriped pavement; new curbs, vehicle stops and medians, new steel fencing, and new landscaping with native drought-tolerant vegetation.

Security guard hours have also been extended for an additional 2 hours each weekday and security is now being provided on Saturdays. New security hours are Monday through Saturday from 5 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Pomona commuters are encouraged to take advantage of the newly renovated Park and Ride lot especially since the nearby Via Verde Park and Ride lot is at capacity.

“The great landscaping, parking upgrades and extended security hours will make the Fairplex lot a first choice among commuters,” said Wendy Bui, Public Works Transit Manager.
