## **PUBLIC INPUT AT AVIATION COMMISSION MEETINGS**

The meetings of the Aviation Commission are open to the public. A member of the public may address the Commission on one agenda item per meeting, and a request to address the Commission must be submitted in person to the Commission staff prior to the start of the meeting. A speaker's time is limited to three minutes, at the discretion of the Chairman. The Commission may limit the public input on any item based on the number of people requesting to speak and the business of the Commission.

In addition, a member of the public has the right to address the Commission on items of interest which are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Commission during the Public Comment portion of the meeting. A person may make a presentation on non-agenda items, but the total presentation shall not exceed three minutes in length, at the discretion of the Chairman. At the discretion of the Chairman, no more than five persons may address the Commission on non-agenda items at any meeting.

In accordance with the Brown Act, all matters to be acted on by the Commission must be posted at least 72 hours prior to the Commission meeting. In case of an emergency, or when a subject matter needs immediate action or comes to the attention of the Commission subsequent to the agenda being posted, upon making certain findings, the Commission may act on an item that was not on the posted agenda.

### **CONDUCT IN THE COMMISSION ROOM**

The Commission has adopted the following rules for conduct during the meetings:

The Chairman shall order removed from the Commission room any person who commits the following acts in respect to a regular or special meeting of the Aviation Commission:

- (a) Disorderly, contemptuous or insolent behavior toward the Commission or any member thereof, tending to interrupt the due and orderly course of said meeting;
- (b) A breach of the peace, boisterous conduct or violent disturbance, tending to interrupt the due and orderly course of said meeting;
- (c) Disobedience of any lawful order of the Chairman, which shall include an order to be seated or to refrain from addressing the Commission; and
- (d) Any other unlawful interference with the due and orderly course of said meeting.

Any person so removed shall be excluded from further attendance at the meeting from which he has been removed, unless permission to attend be granted upon motion adopted by a majority vote of the Commission.

### **INFORMATION RELATING TO AGENDAS AND COMMISSION ACTIONS**

Agendas for the Commission meetings are prepared by the Aviation Division staff the week prior to the scheduled Commission meetings. Agendas and supporting documents are available by calling (626) 300-4602 and can be transmitted by facsimile machine.

Every meeting of the Aviation Commission is recorded on cassette, and duplicate tapes are available for a nominal charge.

After each Commission meeting, minutes are prepared which indicate the discussions and the actions of the Commission.
