GLAZING IN WALLS AND FENCES USED AS BARRIERS FOR POOLS

Item 9.2 of Section 2406.4 in the 1996 Los Angeles County Building Code (LACBC) is a new requirement adopted into the County Code based on the 1994 edition of the Uniform Building Code (UBC). This item requires safety glazing in walls and fences used as the safety barrier for swimming pools and spas when the glazing is within five feet of the pool or spa deck.

Item 9.2 has been amended in the 1997 edition of the UBC to require safety glazing when the glazing is within five feet of the swimming pool or spa water's edge. This change will be reflected in the next edition of the LACBC and should be accepted for current projects.
