• Project Scope:

The primary objective of this project is to install various traffic calming features including traffic circles, bulb-outs, signage, and pavement markings. Budlong Av from Imperial Hwy to El Segundo Bl will also be marked as a bike boulevard.

• Project Benefits:

The project seeks to provide safety improvements for cyclists and pedestrians using various traffic calming measures such as traffic circles and bulb-outs. The bulb-outs also minimize the distance pedestrians must travel to cross intersections, providing an added measure of safety.


• Community Outreach:

Public Works worked with a consultant to hold two community meetings to garner public input on the project. Public Works also actively sought input from first responders who provided valuable feedback. A community meeting is planned for the month prior to the start of construction to remind the public of the project and to let them know the tentative schedule for construction. A project information flyer and a pre-construction brochure will be provided just after the project is awarded and a week prior to start of construction, respectively.
