

## East Los Angeles Community Roadway Improvement

- **Project Scope:**

The primary objective of this project is to improve 2.3 miles of roadway on Whittier Boulevard and 2.1 miles of roadway on Olympic Boulevard.

- Pavement resurfacing
- Parkway improvements
- Upgrade traffic signals
- Street light relocations

- **Project Benefits:**

Improves quality of life for residents and lessens wear and tear on vehicles. Also reduces delay experienced by motorists, which helps improve safety and reduce fuel consumption and emissions.

- **Project Location:** Community of East Los Angeles and Cities of Commerce and Montebello.

Olympic Boulevard – Indiana Street to Goodrich Boulevard  
Whittier Boulevard – Burger Avenue to School Avenue  
Whittier Boulevard – Hendricks Avenue to 20 feet east of Via Clemente

- **Community Outreach:**

A community meeting will be scheduled. A project information flyer and a construction brochure will be provided just after the project has been awarded and a week prior to start of construction, respectively.

- **Cost Estimate:**

- Total Project: \$8.9 Million
- Construction: \$6 Million
- Reimbursable Federal Grant Funds: \$6.6 million

- **Estimated Start of Construction:** September 2019
