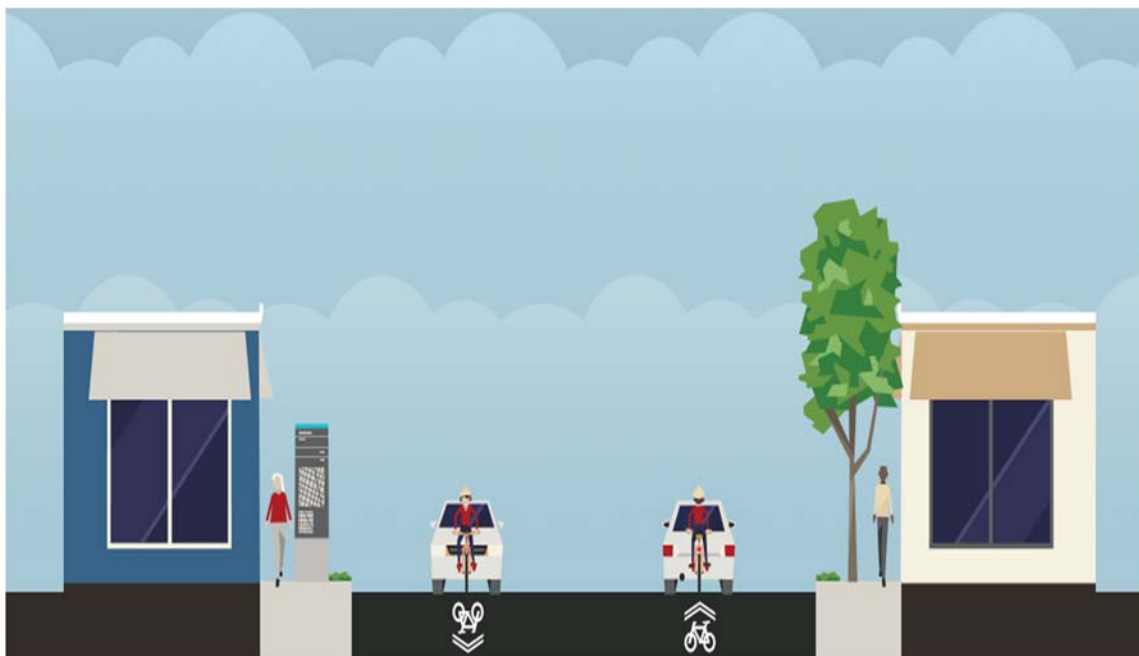
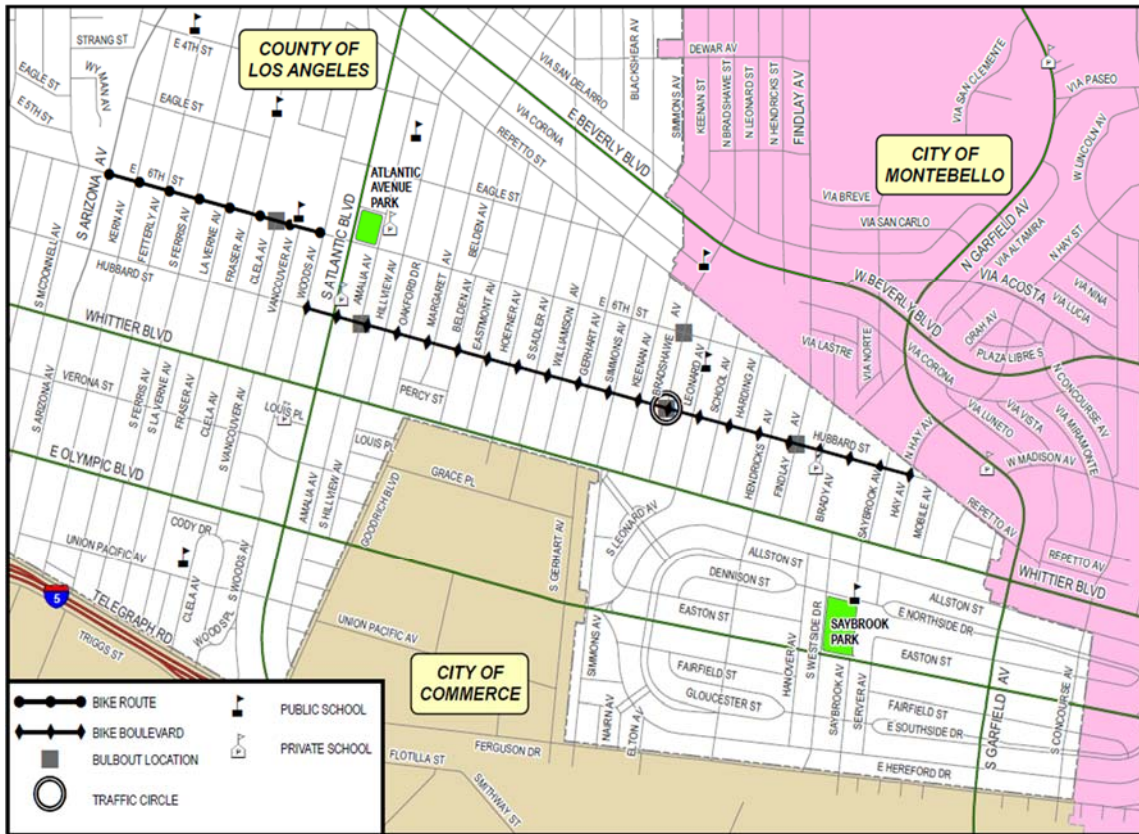


East Los Angeles Community Safe Routes to School

East Los Angeles Community Safe Routes to School

- **Project Scope:**

The project includes traffic calming measures and bike routes.

- Bike Routes with traffic calming (Bike Boulevards) and Bike Lanes
- Construction of Traffic Circles and Bulb-outs (traffic calming)
- Pavement reconstruction at some intersections

- **Project Benefits:**

This bikeway project will improve access for bicyclists to schools and parks in the area and provide interconnectivity among the community of East Los Angeles and City of Montebello.

- **Community Outreach:**

The project was presented to the community on November 16, 2016. A small group of people and the Garfield High School Principal attended the meeting. They were in support of the project. A project information flyer and a pre-construction brochure will be provided just after the project has been awarded and a week prior to start of construction, respectively. Another community meeting may be scheduled just prior to construction.

- 6th Street - Arizona Avenue to Woods Avenue
- 6th Street at Bradshawe Street
- Hubbard Street - Woods Avenue to Hays Avenue

- **Cost Estimate:**

- Total Project: \$1,500,000
- Contract: \$544,000
- Reimbursable State Grant Funds: \$810,000

- **Economic Impact:** Project construction supports 7 direct and indirect jobs.

- **Estimated Start of Construction:** September 2017
