

## Florence-Firestone Community Safe Routes to School

- **Project Scope:**

The primary objective of this project is to construct pedestrian access improvements at nine signalized and non-signalized intersections near four elementary and two middle schools.

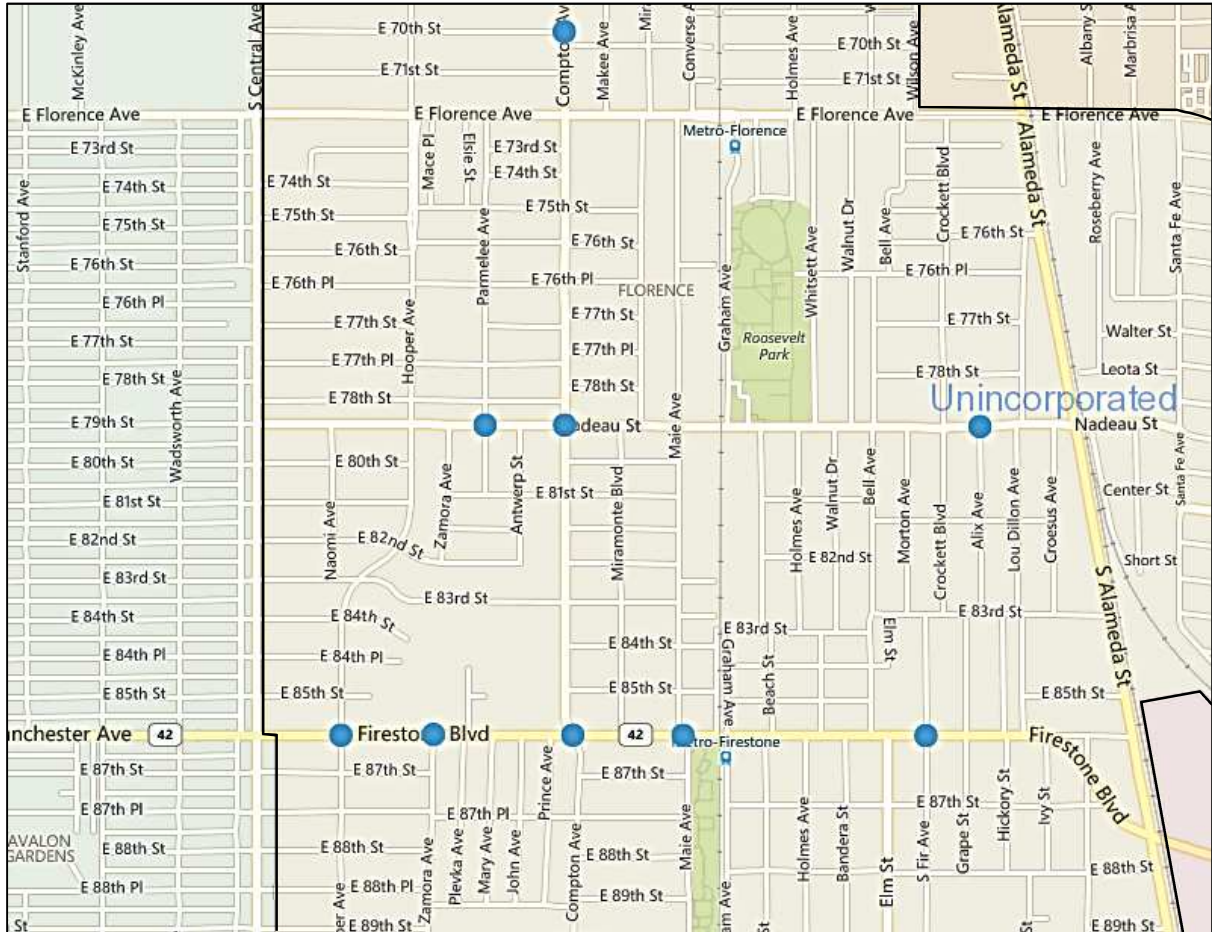
- Construction of bulb-outs
  - Installation of countdown pedestrian heads and audible push buttons
  - Enhanced crosswalks and upgraded curb ramps
  - Installation of bike racks
- **Project Benefits:** This project will enhance the overall safety of pedestrians by increasing their visibility and shorten the time in which the pedestrians will be in the roadway. It will promote a walkable environment and improve accessibility for area residents, especially students.
  - **Community Outreach:** A project information flyer and a pre-construction brochure will be provided just after the project has been awarded and a week prior to start of construction, respectively.
  - **Project Location:** Unincorporated County community of Florence-Firestone
    - Compton Avenue and 70<sup>th</sup> street
    - Compton Avenue and Nadeau Street
    - Compton Avenue and Firestone Boulevard
    - Nadeau Street and Parmalee Avenue
    - Nadeau Street and Alix Avenue
    - Firestone Boulevard and Hooper Avenue
    - Firestone Boulevard and Zamora Avenue
    - Firestone Boulevard and Maie Avenue
    - Firestone Boulevard and Fir Avenue
  - **Cost Estimate:**
    - Total Project: \$1.54 Million
    - Construction: \$800,000
    - Reimbursable State Grant Funds: \$850,000
  - **Economic Impact:** Project construction supports 10 direct and indirect jobs.
  - **Estimated Start of Construction:** September 2017
