

Fullerton Rd at Pathfinder Rd, Et Al.

- **Project Scope:**

The primary objective of this project is to provide roadway and traffic signal improvements at the intersections of Brea Canyon Cutoff Road at Pathfinder Road and Fullerton Road at Pathfinder Road.

- Pavement resurfacing and reconstruction
- Sidewalk improvements
- Upgrade traffic signals
- Street light relocations

- **Project Benefits:**

The implementation of this project will reduce congestion and improve regional mobility for automobiles and pedestrians.

- **Community Outreach:**

A project information flyer and a pre-construction brochure will be provided just after the project has been awarded and a week prior to start of construction, respectively.

- **Project Location:** Unincorporated County community of Rowland Heights and the City of Diamond Bar.

- Brea Canyon Cutoff Road - 650 feet North of Pathfinder Road to 109 feet South of Pathfinder Road.
- Fullerton Road – 865 feet West of Harbor Boulevard to Harbor Boulevard.
- Pathfinder Road – 325 feet West of Brea Canyon Cutoff Road to 32 feet West of Peaceful Hills Road.

- **Cost Estimate:**

- Total Project: \$3.4 million
- Construction: \$1.9 million
- Reimbursable Local Funds awarded through Metro: \$459,000



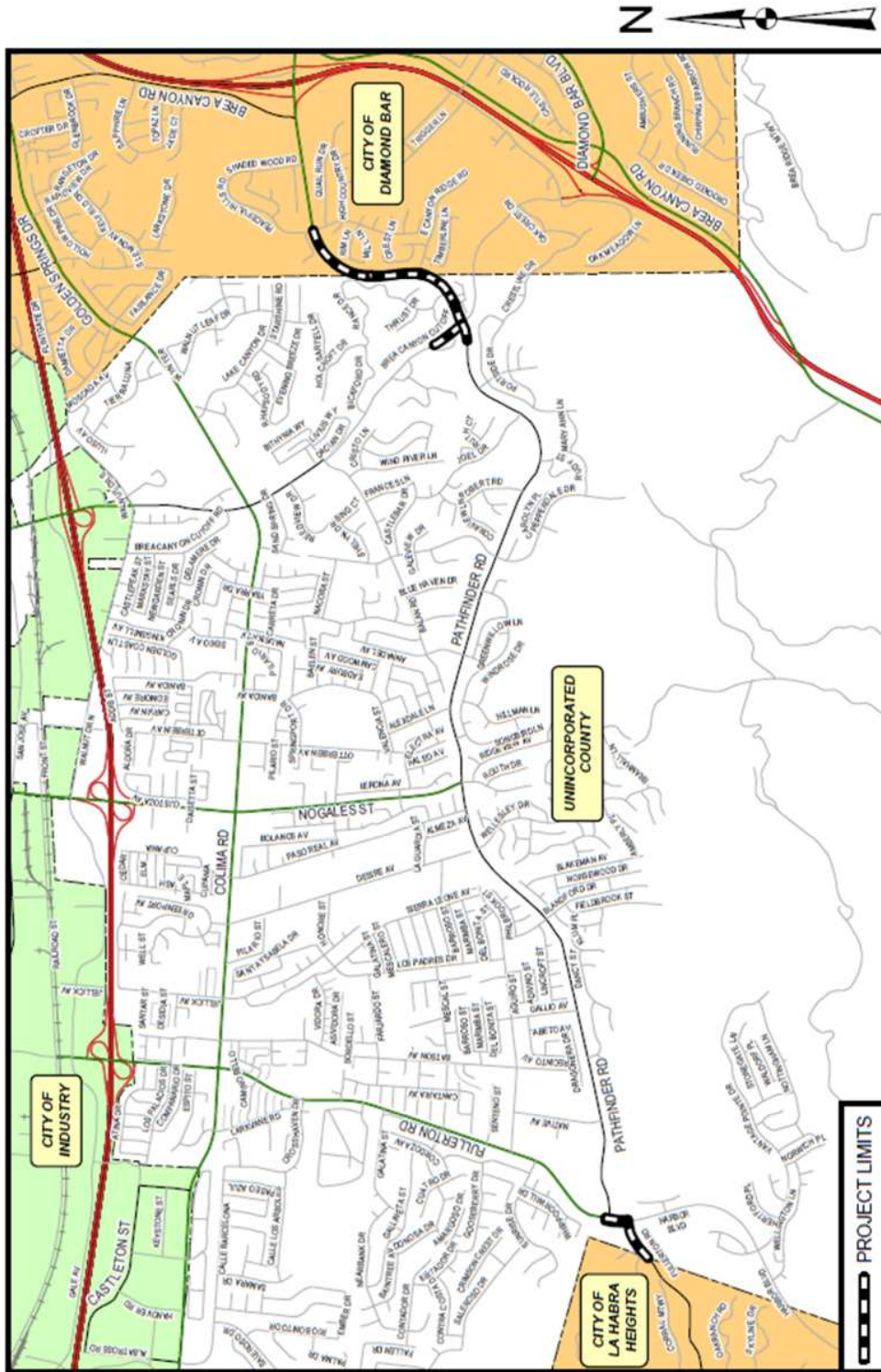
- **Economic Impact:** Project construction supports 24 direct and indirect jobs.
