• Project Scope:

The primary objective of this project is to improve pedestrian access along Overhill Drive.

- o Construction of a pedestrian path along the east side of Overhill Drive
- o Installation of pedestrian lights
- o Removal and planting of trees

• Project Benefits:

This project will improve public health by providing a convenient walking path between La Brea Avenue and Slauson Avenue. The path will enable area residents to walk to neighborhood businesses and encourage exercise by providing connectivity to nearby park amenities.

Community meetings were conducted on September 14, 2015 and on October 10, 2015. A project information flyer and a pre-construction brochure will be provided just after the project has been awarded and a week prior to start of construction, respectively.



- Estimated Start of Construction: Summer 2018


