
## **Slauson Avenue Revitalization**

#### Slauson Avenue Revitalization

### • Project Scope:

Public Works was tasked to develop alternatives to enhance the aesthetics and walkability that supports the commercial revitalization and town center destination concept envisioned for the Slauson Avenue corridor.

- Raised landscaped median islands
- o Pavement resurfacing
- o Bike routes
- Parkway beautification: New trees, planters, pedestrian lighting, bus stop shelters and trash receptacles.

## • Project Benefits:

This project enhances the economic viability of the Slauson Corridor by improving residents' quality of life while giving businesses an economic boost.

### • Community Outreach:

The project was presented to the community at several meetings hosted by the Second District, the latest being on September 14, 2015. Almost 200 people attended the meeting. They were in support of this project. On December 9, 2015 a project information flyer was mailed out and a pre-construction brochure was provided prior to the start of construction.

• **Project location:** Unincorporated County communities of View Park and Windsor Hills

Total Project: \$4.3 millionConstruction: \$2.2 million
