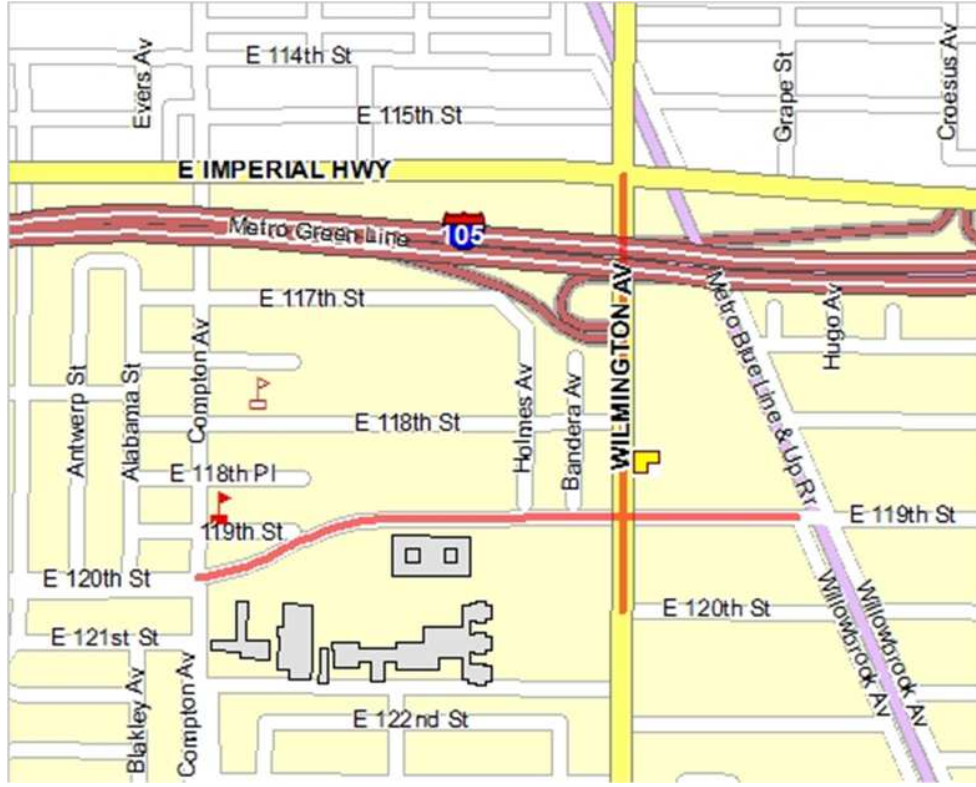


Willowbrook Area Access Improvements

Willowbrook Area Access Improvements

- **Project Scope:**

The primary objective of this project is to improve mobility of pedestrians and bicyclists in the vicinity of the Martin Luther King Jr. Community Hospital.

- Bike routes/lanes
 - Pavement repair, curb ramp upgrades, and crosswalk/sidewalk enhancements
 - New raised landscaped medians and new landscaped parkways
 - New and improved site furnishings (bus stop shelters, benches, trash receptacles, and bike racks)
 - New pedestrian lighting
 - Removal of 55 parkway trees which are damaging public improvements and planting of 126 trees
 - Wayfinding and monument signage – being done as a separate project
- **Project Benefits:** This project enhances pedestrian and bicyclists' movement in the Willowbrook area and improves connections to key attractions.
 - **Community Outreach:** Project scope has been presented at many community meetings since early 2014 through May 2016. Second Supervisorial District staff attended many of these meetings. A project information flyer and a pre-construction brochure were provided prior to start of construction.
 - **Project Location:** Unincorporated County community of Willowbrook
 - Wilmington Av from Imperial Hwy to 480 feet south of 120th St
 - 120th St from Compton Av to Wilmington Av
 - 119th Street from Wilmington Av to Willowbrook Av
 - **Cost Estimate:**
 - Total Project: \$7.2 million*
 - Construction: \$3.1 million*
 - Reimbursable Federal Grant Funds: \$4 million

* not including wayfinding and monument signage

- **Economic Impact:** Project construction supports 38 direct and indirect jobs.
- **Construction Timeline:** December 2016 through September 2017
