
Willowbrook Area Access Improvements - Wayfinding Signs

• Project Scope:

The primary objective of this project is to improve mobility of pedestrians and bicyclists in the vicinity of the Martin Luther King Jr. Community Hospital by installing monument and wayfinding signage.

Project Benefits:

This project enhances wayfinding in the Willowbrook area and improves pedestrian and bicyclists' movement to and from key attractions.

Community Outreach:

The scope of work has been presented to the community many times as part of the scope of work for Willowbrook Area Access Improvements project. The project information flyer and pre-construction brochure for the Willowbrook Area Access Improvements project were both provided to the community in December 2016 prior to start of construction. The flyer and brochure also included details regarding this monument and wayfinding signage project. The community is in support of both projects.
