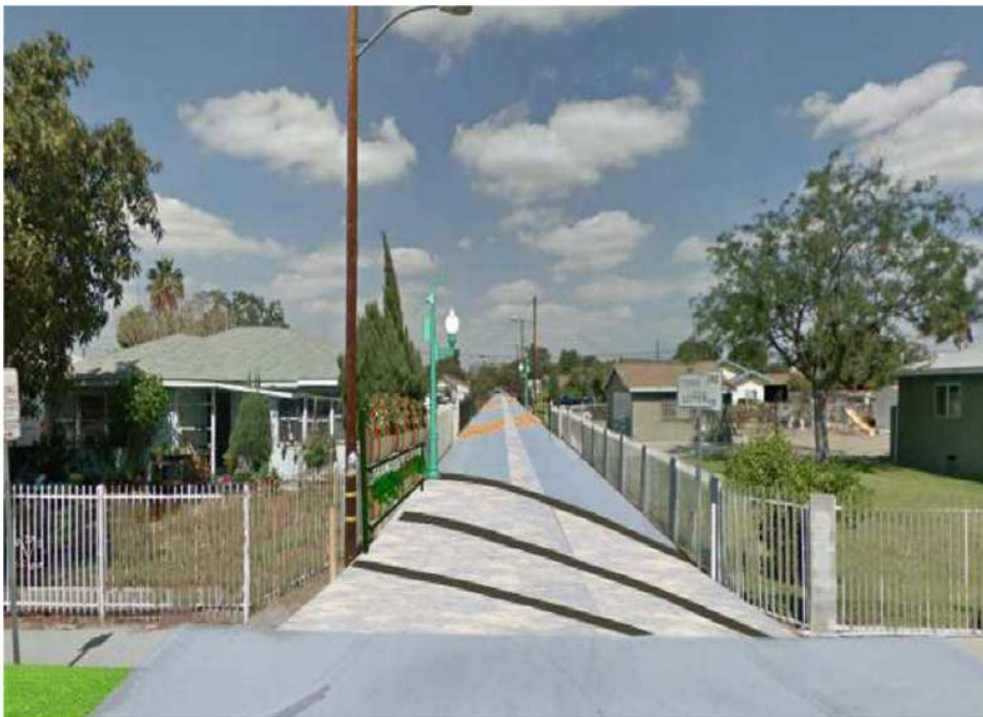


Willowbrook Green Alley Project

Willowbrook Green Alley Project

- **Project Scope:**

- Pavement reconstruction
- Pedestrian lighting
- Decorative walls that hold potted plants
- Curb ramp and driveway reconstruction at the alley entrance
- Crosswalk enhancements
- Installation of monument signs that identify the alley as Green Alley of Family and Fellowship

Project development began in January 2015 as a 'pilot' project for transforming alleyways into multi-purpose community assets.

- **Project Benefits:**

This project complements the on-going improvements in Willowbrook and improves access to the new Faith & Hope Park and Mona Park. It promotes community space that provides neighborhood identity, encourages a healthy lifestyle with a safe, accessible, and creative space where neighbors can meet and come together as a community.

- **Community Outreach:**

The project was presented to the community on April 6, 2016. The purpose of the community meeting was to discuss the construction impacts such as alley closures and remote parking arrangements, etc.

- **Project Location:** Willowbrook

Alley connecting East 118th St to East 120th St, between Willowbrook Av and Mona Bl

- **Cost Estimate:**

- Total Project: \$1.3 million
- Construction: \$740,000

- **Economic Impact:** Project construction supports 9 direct and indirect jobs.

- **Construction timeline:** October 2016 through April 2017
