

## Franklin Fire Incident Report:

This is the **initial** incident report for the brushfire which occurred at the canyons near Malibu Canyon Road and Malibu Creek State Park, north of Pacific Coast Highway in the Unincorporated Los Angeles County area and the City of Malibu.

Approximate Area Burned:	<b>+/- 4,037 Acres</b>
Approximate Area:	(Firefighters are making steady progress, supported by an anticipated increase in relative humidity overnight and the persistence of weak northeasterly winds into the evening. Crews continue to balance structure defense with efforts to establish and strengthen the fire's perimeter control. Fire behavior has remained moderate throughout the day.)

## Potential Sediment Impact:

- The fire occurred in the Los Angeles County Flood Control District boundary.
- Media outlets reported 20 structures destroyed and 28 structures damaged.
- During significant storm events, increased mud and debris flows may flow towards residential, commercial, Pepperdine University infrastructure \ community within Los Angeles County Unincorporated area and the City of Malibu and Malibu Canyon Road (County maintained).
- There are several County Flood Control maintained structures such as storm drain inlets and drainage devices (Marie Canyon Debris Regulating Inlet) may be impacted during major storm events.
- Fire investigation is recommended to verify impacts to residential, commercial, and educational properties and County maintained infrastructure.
