Hangar inspections are available every day of the week from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Also, do not wait until the last minute to schedule your inspection. The deadline to schedule inspections is October 31, 2024.

County Airports Serve As Cooling Centers During the Hot Summer Months

This year has been and continues to be a hot one! In fact, temperatures in Los Angeles reached 114 degrees this summer, which some climate officials have said has been the hottest on record.

The County's Office of Emergency Management coordinates with various partners/public facilities throughout the County to provide Cooling Centers (indoor air-conditioned locations) where people can keep cool during periods of extreme heat weather conditions.

During periods of excessive heat warnings (when temperatures meet or exceed 105 degrees for at least two days), the terminal buildings at the County's airports, particularly General Wm. J. Fox Airfield in Lancaster, Whiteman Airport in Pacoima, and San Gabriel Valley Airport in El Monte, have been made available this summer as Cooling Centers.

Hopefully, we'll now see a cooling trend as we leave summer and enter fall. However, the County's airports will continue to serve as Cooling Centers when needed, which is one more way the airports can serve not only general aviation but the diverse constituents of, and visitors to, the County of Los Angeles.
