Public Information Workshops Los Angeles County Construction and Demolition Debris Recycling and Reuse Ordinance

The County of Los Angeles Department of Public Works will conduct two Public Information Workshops for waste haulers and recyclers that transport, process, recycle or reuse construction and demolition (C&D) debris from the County's unincorporated areas.

The purpose of the workshops is to introduce the new *Field Guide to C&D Projects*, provide training for completing required forms, discuss coordination between the haulers/recyclers and builders, and tracking and reporting disposal and diversion.

This Ordinance will increase diversion of C&D debris in the County unincorporated areas. Although it is the responsibility of those in the building community to comply with the requirements of the Ordinance, these builders and contractors will rely on their service providers to assist with C&D debris diversion and tonnage tracking. Waste haulers and recyclers are therefore strongly encouraged to attend these workshops.
