Everyone in unincorporated Los Angeles County must do their part to divert organic waste from landfills to reduce our impact on climate change and the environment. That is why the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors adopted an ordinance that requires all residents and businesses to subscribe to organic waste collection services. SENATE BILL (SB 1383) ORGANIC WASTE REDUCTION AND FOOD DONATION

SB 1383 establishes the following targets to reduce methane emissions:

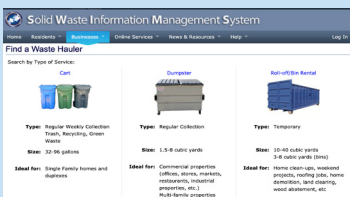

CUSTOMER BILL OF RIGHTS

What We Will Collect. We will collect refuse, green waste, and commingled recyclables in bins and/or carts we provide. You must place refuse, recyclable materials, and green waste in the appropriate bins and/or carts. We will not pick up materials that you discard outside of bins and/or carts unless you have made previous arrangements with us, as described below.

As a single-family household, a large portion of your waste may be organic materials, such as green waste, food scraps, and food-soiled paper.
