SENATE BILL (SB 1383) ORGANIC WASTE REDUCTION AND FOOD DONATION

ORGANIC WASTE REDUCTION TARGETS

SB 1383 establishes the following targets to reduce methane emissions:

75% reduction in statewide organic waste disposal by

2025

and not less than

20% recovery of edible food for human consumption

Treated and/or painted wood cannot be recycled as green waste.
