

Self-Management Plan Checklist for Self-Haulers/On-Site Management

- Read [Mandatory Organic Waste Disposal Reduction Ordinance](#).
- Read [Ordinance Guidelines](#).
- Create a Self-Management Plan that complies with the Ordinance and Guidelines.
 - Determine how organic waste will be managed (ex. composted or self-hauled to community composting site.)
 - If self-hauling, determine what composting site will be used and ensure they can accept the waste you generate. Review [Facilities List](#).
 - Determine how organic waste will be stored on site including number of containers.
 - Determine how to maintain records of organic waste generated and self-hauled.
- File a Self-Management application ([available here](#)).
- Submit application to CommercialFranchise@dpw.lacounty.gov.
- Wait for approval and confirmation from Public Works. You may need to provide more information, if requested.
- Once approved, it is a requirement for commercial customers to maintain records monthly and report to the County when requested on their self-managed waste collections such Organics, Recyclables, and/or Trash. Please use the following PDF to report: [Self-Management Reporting](#).
