Dear Property Owner:

Public Works is pleased to host a second community meeting for affected property owners regarding a request for streetlights in your area (see attached map). The purpose of the meeting is to ensure the property owners understand the legal requirements and type and location of the proposed streetlights.

Petition No. 56-1017 was signed by property owners representing 66 percent of the area proposed for annexation and met the County's minimum signature requirement of 60 percent to initiate an annexation. The proposed annexation, if approved by the property owners, will result in a new annual assessment on your property tax bills of \$5 per single-family residence to supplement the operation and maintenance costs of the streetlights.
